In 1966 Mower Charolais began when Lamar Mower acquired a small herd of Charolais cattle. Then in 1971 he decided to try his hand in registered Charolais. Purchasing cattle from Litton Charolais in Missouri, and Barton Charolais in Manti, Utah.

In the late 70's and early 80's he had a show string, with moderate success. In 1981 he won the pen of Charolais and Charolais cross steers at the Arizona National. He also showed in various local shows.



After Lamar passed away in 2000, and having a closed herd for 20 years. We began searching for new genetics to introduce into our herd. In our search we have emphasized calving ease, moderate frame, polled genetics and structurally sound cows with quiet dispositions. They must also raise a good calf and breed back quickly.

Some of our herd matrons include NF H845 Daughter 914, high selling lot and CR Miss Perfection 7140 P which was the 3rd high seller in the Wienk Charolais 2004 female sale. Our other foundation females include WCR Paulette 8012 ET P, VCR Miss Mac 220 P, M6 Ms 062 Grid Maker 4173, and M6 Grid Maker 5197PLDET a daughter of DR Forever Lucy 401.

We will continue our search diligently for quality genetics, and use proven A.I sires that will produce profitable cattle for ourselves as well as our customers.
